HAPPY - We make new and happy memories together.

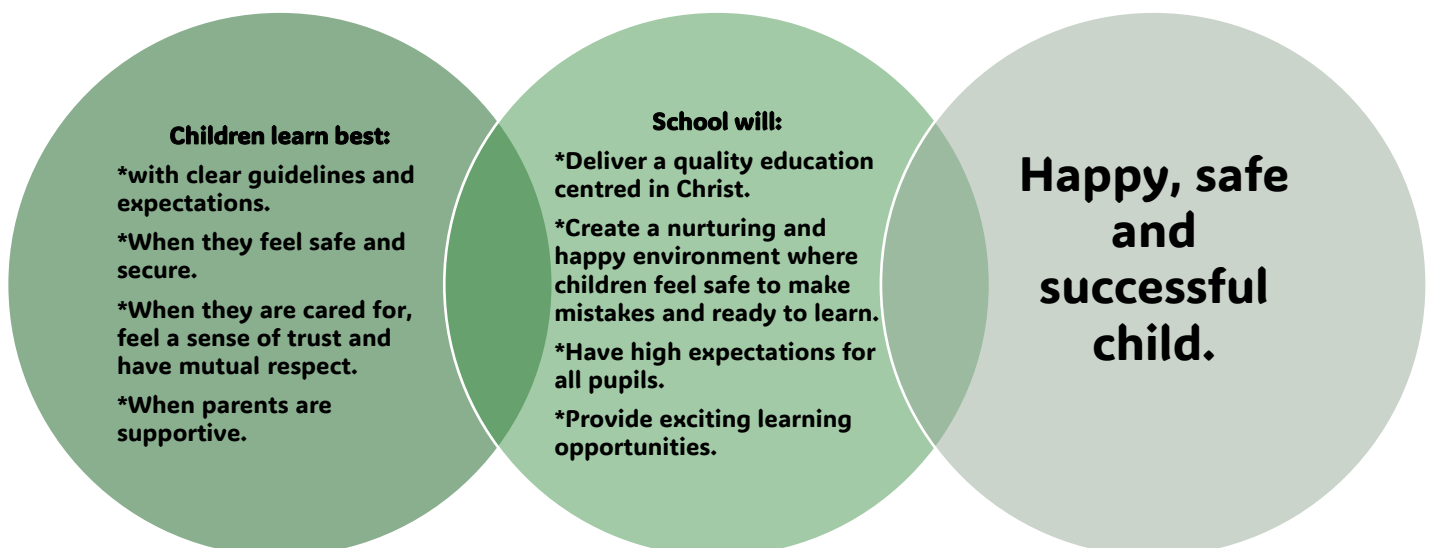
CARING - We are caring, kind and amazing just like Jesus.
