News Updates:

We will be focusing lots of literacy work on the topic of plants and story writing. The role play will be transformed into a garden centre. In science, the children will be learning about Connections where we will focus on investigating science through stories. We will investigate things like, 'Do taller trees have wider trunks?' and think about how different animals build their homes. In history, the children will be learning about how explorers have changed the world and how exploration has changed over the years. They will find out about famous explorers from the past and make comparisons. In DT, the children will be learning about food and nutrition and will use this knowledge to design and make a smoothie. In computing, the children will learn about Tech outside school. Our R.E topic will be Dialogue and Encounter and children will learn about respect and other religions. In maths, we will be continuing to work on place value and also beginning to think about multiplication and division, as well as fractions and time.
