# Catholic Social Teaching



This week, we are reflecting on the Catholic Social Teaching principle of Preferential Option for the Poor. This principle reminds us that Jesus calls us to show special care and concern for those who are poor, vulnerable or in need. It encourages us to put the needs of others first and to work towards a world where everyone is treated with dignity, fairness and compassion.

**In Matthew 25:40, Jesus tells us, “Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me,” reminding us that when we help those in need, we are serving Christ Himself.**

We can live out this principle this week by showing kindness to those who may be lonely, sharing what we have with others, supporting charitable causes and looking out for anyone who may need a helping hand. At OLMC, we demonstrate a Preferential Option for the Poor through our fundraising for charities, supporting local and global communities in need, and ensuring that everyone feels valued, included and cared for.
